What free support services do we deliver?

Practical support, education and advocacy for parents to identify and overcome barriers that hinder their ability to care for their children and to work towards the best possible outcomes for their families.

Practical Support Services

- Tailored case management
- One-on-one counselling and life coaching
- Advisory support
- Connection to wrap-around support services such as domestic violence, housing, specialised counselling and substance abuse

Advocacy

- Support and attendance during DCP and associated service meetings
- Individual support and attendance during court appointments

Showing Up For Your Kids | A FREE two-day workshop is delivered separately for mums and dads to ensure a safe environment which fosters genuine engagement and participation.

Participants work through understanding the child protection system processes and expectations of DCP. An experienced lawyer joins us to give insight into the possible pathways once a child has been removed and how to navigate the legal aspects. Participants bring along their own case plans to familiarise parents with the document and understand what action is required. This session also focuses on how parents can make the most of access visits with their child by making meaningful connections and understanding connection impacts from a child's perspective.


